James, a slave of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ
-- Jam 1:1

δοῦλος is better translated as "slave"


James knew that to serve God and others . . . we must think of ourselves as the slaves of God – letting God live through us instead of putting our own wants and desires first.

## The BIG Catch

Slavery to God requires that we also serve others – even our enemies.

"But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you" (Matt 5:44)

"Whoever wishes to be great among you must be your servant" (Mar 10:43)



## James doesn't tell us . . .

- Your problems will go away when you become a Christian
- Your problems won't hurt any more when you become a Christian
- Good Christians don't have problems
- Smart, well-prepared people don't have problems
- You should be ashamed of your problems.

James says "WHEN" you have problems.

If you are a follower of Christ, problems are either here or coming.

Expect them, but serve God despite them.

### James Tells us the Truth about Problems

#### What We Often Think. . .

- Problems are obstacles to happiness
- Problems are obstacles to doing God's work
- We should (always) avoid problems
- Problems scar us.

#### What James teaches . . .

- Problems are occasions for joy
- Problems shouldn't stop us from serving God.
- Endure (not avoid) problems
- Problems make us mature and complete

**Living Faith** serves God and others regardless of any problems we might face.

**Dead faith** sits around believing God will fix our problems,

give us more of what we want, and be on our side in any

conflict.
