name of the Lord
Jesus Christ and in the
Spirit of our God.
(1Co 6:11 NRS)



You have been set aside for a Holy Purpose!

"For you are God's
masterpiece, created in
Christ Jesus to do good
works, which God prepared
in advance for you to do"
(Eph 2:10).



You can not fully dance in the Spirit
until you have accepted that
you have been set aside for holy use.

“I have been set aside for Holy Use!”

Comforter or Advocate?

Jesus said, “I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **Advocate**, to be with you forever. (Joh 14:16-17 NRS)

- Advocate was a legal term – an expert legal advisor who went with you to court.
- It can also mean helper.
- It was originally translated Comforter.

Comfort of the Holy Spirit

After Pentecost . . .

“Meanwhile the church . . .
was built up. Living in the
fear of the Lord and in the
comfort of the Holy Spirit, it
increased in numbers” (Act
9:31 NRS)



Comfort happens when we have our Eyes on God (2Ch 20:12)

For we are powerless against
this great multitude that is
coming against us. We do not
know what to do, **but our
eyes are on you.**"

'Do not fear or be dismayed
at this great multitude; for
the battle is not yours but
God's. Take your position and
stand still.

**"Give thanks to the LORD,
for his steadfast love
endures forever!"**

Find Comfort by Putting Your Eyes on God
and praising God!

How do you get Wisdom?

If any of you is lacking wisdom, ask God, who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly, and it will be given you.
(Jam 1:6 NRS)



King Solomon

That night God appeared to Solomon, and said to him, "Ask what I should give you."

Solomon said to God . . .
"Give me now wisdom
and knowledge to . . .
rule this great people of
yours . . . " (2Ch 1:7-12
NRS)



It is a promise that if you ask for wisdom,
God will give it to you! A promise!

Power

The one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father. (Joh 14:12-14 NRS)

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you
(Act 1:8 NRS)



God did not give us a spirit of cowardice, but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline. (2Ti 1:7 NRS)
